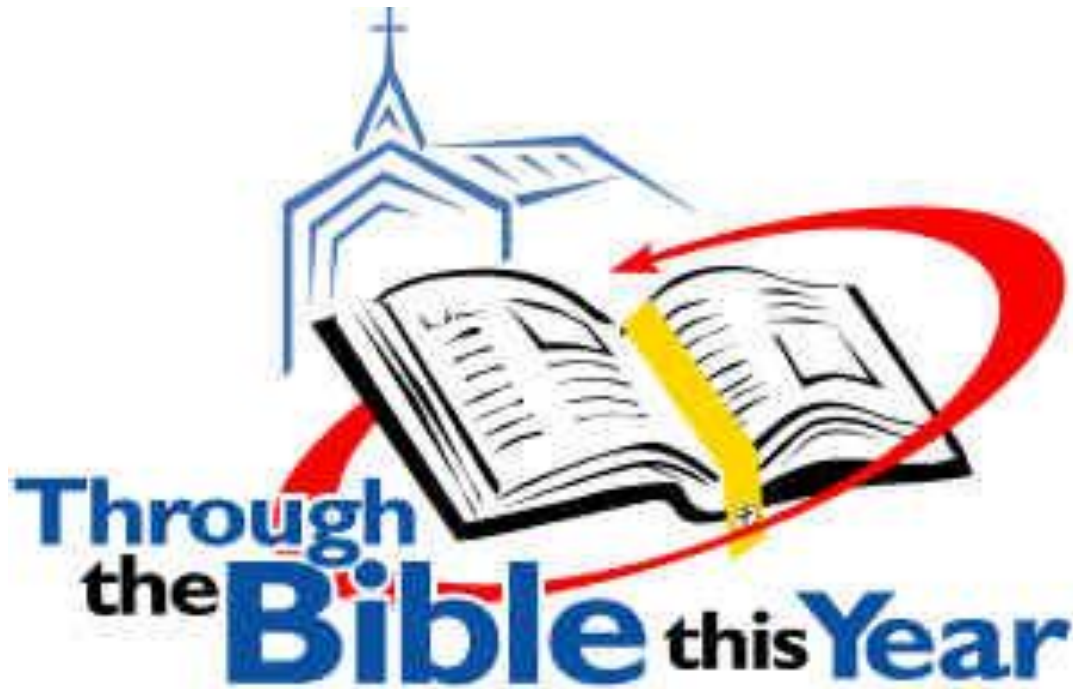
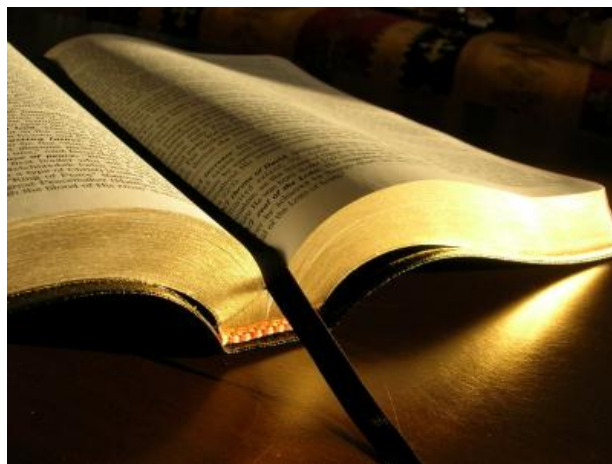


A Plan for Congregational Bible Reading and Teaching



The New Testament 2012



Through the NT in 2012 at LaGrange Church of Christ

Through the New Testament in 2012 is a congregational plan for Bible reading and teaching that can help us all grow in the knowledge and understanding of God. On the following pages, you will find a 2012 calendar with assigned Bible readings. The readings are divided weekly so that each reader can decide for himself how to cover the material. If you want to cover approximately the same amount of text each day, divide the number of pages for the week's reading by seven. On the other hand, you may want to cover the week's reading multiple times by reading the assigned text in just one or two days. The weekly assignments can be adapted to fit your preferred method and schedule.

Our reading schedule covers the New Testament scriptures once in eleven months. You will be reading just 5 chapters on average per week. Sometimes, of course, the daily requirement may be a bit more, and at other times it will be less. Not all of the chapters in the Bible are the same length either. Do not become discouraged if you fall behind. Stay on schedule. **If you want to make up what you missed, do so after completing the current week's reading.** Catch-up/Review weeks are scheduled after the NT narratives (Gospels and Acts) and after finishing the writings of Paul (Romans-Philemon).

Each month's calendar is small enough to fit inside the cover of most Bibles. You may prefer to post the calendar on the refrigerator or tape it to your computer or television as a reminder to do your daily reading. Encourage the whole family to get involved in reading the Bible. Middle school children should be able to complete each week's assigned reading. Part or all of the weekly readings could even be read aloud as part of a family devotional. By encouraging the entire family to get involved, we help our children understand the importance of the Bible and its prominence in our daily lives and in the life of the church.

Consider purchasing a notebook to keep a journal of your daily readings. This journal does not have to be extensive or take up much of your time. Simply write down the date and the chapters you read. Write down the citation for verses that stand out to you, questions you may have, and meaningful passages you want to remember and/or share with others. Then jot down three things about that day's reading: **Your Favorite Part, Something New** that you don't remember seeing before, and **A Practical Application**. You do not have to write an essay. Just make a note of the verse or verses and keep reading.

This year the Youth Bible Drill classes will be following the congregational reading schedule and discussing the reading each week. By following this Bible reading schedule and noting the three key parts mentioned above, our young people will be prepared for all of their Sunday Bible classes and will gain a valuable overview of the entire New Testament.

Our sermons each Sunday will also be taken from the congregational reading schedule. Each Lord's Day morning we will focus on specific passages, themes, and concepts from the previous week's reading. By participating in the congregational reading plan, you will be prepared to get the most out of each week's sermon. The text for each week's lesson will be announced a week in advance, allowing you to spend extra time meditating on that passage or idea prior to our Sunday study.
